Chainsaws are one of the most dangerous power-tools you can own. Careful maintenance and expertise are very important when it comes to owning and safely operating a chainsaw. The public is invited to participate in a free chainsaw skills and safety workshop geared toward novice operators.

Chainsaw maintenance, safety, proper bucking and felling techniques will be demonstrated. Protective gear will be available for those wishing to take part. Participants can bring their own chainsaws. Please wear long sleeves, long pants, and closed-toe shoes appropriate for walking through the woods.
